



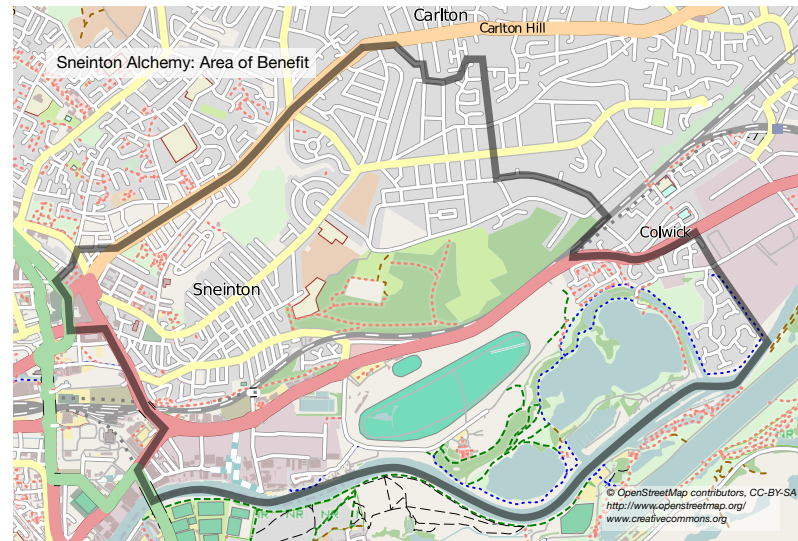

Membership benefits

The principal benefit of joining Alchemy as a corporate member is to have a voice in deciding how the CIC determines and prioritises its activities in its Area of Benefit. Corporate members are entitled to:

- Participate in Sneinton Alchemy meetings, including the AGM, and receive notification of other Alchemy events.
- Quarterly e-newsletters and regular bulletins on key issues facing the neighbourhood
- Opportunities to contribute to the work of the Alchemy board and/or other Task Groups set up to tackle specific issues.
- Association with the social, environmental and economic benefits delivered by Sneinton Alchemy, and opportunities to be linked to the Sneinton Alchemy website.
- For the private sector, opportunities through which Corporate Social Responsibility goals can be achieved.



Membership obligations and costs

The principle obligations as a Member are to subscribe and help to further the objectives of the CIC, which are:

To carry on activities which benefit the community and in particular to support the resilience of Sneinton in Nottingham through undertaking projects and activities which combine social, environmental and economic benefit.

These activities will include, but are not limited to, the following:

- To consult and engage the community within the area of benefit, to advocate for the needs of the community and to promote a sense of neighbourhood identity*
- To develop community facilities and assets and to ensure that local development and planning is sensitive to the needs of the community and the heritage of Sneinton and its residents*
- To promote and facilitate community economic development and enterprise support, training and skills development and the building of capacity*

Every member undertakes to contribute **£1** to the assets of the company in the event of the company being wound up while it is a member or within one year after it ceases to be a member.
